DATE: Saturday, April 18, 2015

TIME: Site opens at 9:00 AM. Walk starts at 10:00 AM.

LOCATION: Solberg Airport, 39 Thor-Solberg Rd, Whitehouse Station, NJ 08889

DIRECTIONS: From Route 287, take Exit 17 for Route 202/206 South. Follow Route 202/206 South for approx. 5 miles. Turn right on Old York Road. Old York Road become Dreahook Road. Continue onto Readington Road. Turn Right onto Thor-Solberg Road. From South: Take 195 East to 295 North. Follow 295 North which turns into 95 South. Take Exit 4 for 31 North. Follow 31 North for about 10 miles. Merge right onto Route 202 North/31 North. Continue on 202 North to Old York Road. Turn left onto Holland Brook Road. Continue on Brookview Road. Turn left onto Readington Road. Turn right onto Thor-Solberg Road.

PARKING: Onsite parking available.

What to Expect

We are excited to host this 1.5 mile route on the runway! Walkers can do one loop, or choose to do a second power loop.

The start/finish will feature refreshments and water. There will be a Cheer Zone half way with water as well.

NO DOGS ALLOWED.
