LOCATION: Horseshoe Lake Recreation Complex, 72 Eyland Avenue, Succasunna, NJ 07876

<u>DIRECTIONS:</u> From I-80 East take Exit 28 toward 46 East/Route 10/Ledgewood. Follow Route 10 East to Eyland Ave. Destination is on the left. From I-80 West take Exit 43 to I-287 South. Follow I-287 South to Exit 39. Follow Route 10 West to Eyland Avenue (about 11 miles).

PARKING: Onsite parking lots available.

What to Expect

This route is approx. 3 miles. The route is accessible, however please note that the check-in area, which is under the pavilion, is on a grassy area. Should you need assistance checking in, please ask a volunteer.

The start/finish will feature refreshments and water.
